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### A DREAM EDUCATION PROVIDES:

- **A PATH TO COLLEGE** DREAM offers a rigorous academic curriculum, high expectations, and a strong system of supports designed to ensure that our scholars have the knowledge, skills, and habits necessary to succeed in college and beyond. At DREAM every young person has a champion, or advisor, who helps to identify their strengths and areas of growth, and support them in achieving their goals.
